

Sabitha Thorpe his wife of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina for themselves their heirs, execs, admors & assigns both by their presents, Covenant and grant to and with the (sdg) Henry Welsh his heirs, execs admors and assigns, that they will by their presents manant and forever defend, all right, title, claim or demand of any persons or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof in witness whereof the said Edmund Thorpe, Mary his wife, John Spencer, and Susannah his wife formerly Susannah Thorpe, Joseph Thorpe and Joshua Thorpe of the County of Sampson and State of Virginia (and Joseph Oliver & Sabitha Oliver his wife formerly Sabitha Thorpe of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina both formerly set their hands and affixed their seals this 1st day of December 1818

and Benjⁿ Griffin Justices of the peace in the
County aforesaid in the State of Virginia do
hereby certify that Mary Thorpe wife of Edmund
Thorpe, Susan Spencer the wife of John Spencer
& Sabitha Oliver the wife of Joseph Oliver parties
to the within Deed for the conveyance of real
estate to Henry Welsh bearing date the 1st day
November 1818 personally appeared before us
our Courts aforesaid and being examined by us
privily and apart from their husbands and
having the Deed before said fully explained to
them, that the Mary Thorpe, Susan Spencer and Sabitha Oliver acknowledged
the same to be their acts and Deeds & declared that they had willingly signed
sealed and delivered the same, and that they wished not to retract any of the
contents and seals this 15th day of January 1819.

Sampson County In the clerks office the 3rd day of December 1818
This indenture was acknowledged by Edmund Thorpe, John Spencer, Nancy
Thorpe and Joseph Oliver, and together with a certificate thereon entered
certifying the acknowledgment of Henry examination of the within named Mary
Thorpe, Susannah Spencer and Sabitha Oliver and admitted to record
as to them. And in the clerks office the 17th day of May 1819 was
acknowledged by Joshua Thorpe and admitted to record. And at
a Court held for the aforesaid County on the 21st day of June 1819
this indenture & certificate as aforesaid were entered upon the
proceedings of this day
