This Indenture made this 21st day of
May 1819 Between Nathaniel Boush of the Borough of Norfolk
the 1st part, John Thomas of the County of Southampton
the 2nd part, and James Bryant of the same County of the
3rd part, all of the State of Virginia. Witness that whereas
the said Nathaniel Boush stands justly indebted to the said
John Thomas in the just and full sum of Two thousand four
hundred and eighty seven Dollars and fifty four Cents current
money of Virginia, as will fully appear by a paper meeting
executed by the said Nathaniel Boush in at Norfolk Virginia bearing
date the fourth day of March 1819 attested by one H. Bantz, and
the said Nathaniel Boush, being willing and desirous to secure the
payment of the aforesaid sum of money to the said John Thomas
his heirs and assigns. This Indenture therefore further witnesseth
that the said Nathaniel Boush as well in consideration of the
premises aforesaid as for and in consideration of the sum of one
Dollar to him in hand paid by the said James Bryant the
receipt whereof the said Nathaniel Boush doth hereby acknowledge
Lidger, he the said Nathaniel Boush hath granted, bargained,
sold, and by these presents grant, bargain and sell unto the said
James Bryant his heirs, executors or assigns all his right title
interest, claim and demand whatsoever of or to the undivided
share of James Millar late of Southampton County, To have and
to hold unto the said James Bryant his heirs, executors or assigns
the aforesaid interest of the said Nathaniel Boush of or to the
the aforesaid undivided share, But upon the condition that the said James
Bryant may at any time at the request of the said John Thomas
take possession of any part or the whole of the aforesaid share to
which the said Nathaniel Boush may be entitled whenever found
that the same by virtue of these presents, the profits thereof going
to the credit of the said Nathaniel Boush and it is expressly
agreed and understood between the parties to these presents that
in case the said Nathaniel Boush shall fail to pay or
cause to be paid the aforesaid sum of money to the said John
Thomas, and all interest accruing thereon on or before the 25th
day of November next then and in that case, it shall and
may be lawful for the said James Bryant his executors or assigns
at any time hereafter at the request of the said John
Thomas to make sale of the aforesaid share or so many
thereof, as will be sufficient to pay and satisfy & pay
unto the said John Thomas the aforesaid sum of money and
all interest accruing thereon, and all cost attending the sale as
well as all cost of & concerning these presents, it should there
be any overplus, pay the same to the said Nathaniel Boush
at least two weeks notice of the time and place of sale
to be given in some public paper printed in the Borough
of Norfolk; and at any other public place thought necessary
