other land, to have and to hold the said sixty acres of land be
the same more or less, with all and singular the appurtenances
thereunto belonging to the said William and the said Edwin
B. Claude for himself and his heirs to and with warrant and
force defend the above mentioned lands and premises
unto the said William Claude his heirs, and assigns
forever against the claim or title of all person or
