This Indenture made the 22nd day of January in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between Ephram Reverum of the County of Sampson and State of Virginia and parish of Saint Luke of the one part and Thomas Reverum of the same State County and parish of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Ephram Reverum for and in consideration of the sum of thirty one Dollars and fifty cents good and lawful money of U. S. to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Reverum the receipt whereof the said Ephram Reverum doth hereby acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and paid, hath granted bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed & confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain, sell, alien, convey (and confirm unto the said Thomas Reverum to him and to his heirs forever, one certain tract or parcels of land premises situate lying and being in the County and parish aforesaid and adjoining along the side of the said Ephram Reverum's mill, containing by a late survey made by the City Surveyor of Sampson Co. aforesaid seven and one half acres bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a small gum a corner of Thomas Reverum's standing in a small branch running thence N 74° 12' 38" pole to the run of Thomas Reverum's mill then up the run of the same pond 6 pole to a corner of Ephram Reverum's land on the side of the run of pond thence S 74° 6' 12' 38" pole to a small oak a new corner made in the same branch we start from thence along the said branch 14 pole to the first station, together with all
