This Indenture made and entered into this 25th day of October in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and seventeen between Samuel Bailey of the first part John Urquhart of the second part and Lemuel B. Summers of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said Samuel Bailey for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and eight dollars and ninety two cents which said sum is due from the said Samuel Bailey to the said John Urquhart by bond bearing date the 18th day of October 1817 or more or other moneys which may be due (and arising from the said Bailey to the said Urquhart by means of any dealing, transfer of debt or paper whatsoever, as also for and in consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Lemuel B. Summers the receipt whereof the said Samuel Bailey doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth convey and bargain and sell, convey and make over unto the said Lemuel B. Summers and his heirs forever, all his right and interest in a certain undivided tract of land belonging to the estate of Benjamin Delach deceased lying and being in the County of Hampton, on the south side of Lightfoot swamp and containing five hundred & 54 acres to the said more or less which said land was devised by the said Benj. Delach in his last will and testament to his equally divided between his two sons Allen and Thomas Delach, one moiety of which the said Samuel Bailey claims under the will of the said Thomas Delach which is record in the County Court of Hampton, & to have any to hold with all the right and interest of the said Sam^l Bailey herein conveyed or intended to be conveyed to him the said Lemuel B. Summers his heirs and assigns forever upon this special trust nevertheless that the said Lemuel B. Summers, upon being thereto required by the aforesaid John Urquhart shall proceed to sell all the right and interest of the said Samuel Bailey to the above named Lemuel Bailey conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertising the same and placing in the County of Hampton for ten days previous at some public house or place for cash and out of the money arising out of the said sale, in the first place pay and satisfy all costs attending the said sale of real as the aforesaid attending the said conveyance, and then pay off the bond aforesaid with cost as well as all other moneys which may appear to be due (and owing) from the said Samuel Bailey to the said John Urquhart by means of any dealings transfer of debt or paper whatsoever said the debtor if any pay to the said Samuel Bailey and the said Lemuel B. Summers for himself his heirs executors and administrators of the right and title of the said land unto the said Lemuel B. Summers his heirs and assigns forever with liberty
