This Indenture made this fifth day of June in the
year one thousand eight hundred and nineteen between Alexander P. Peat
and Elizabeth Peat his wife of the one part and Thomas Appelwhite of the
other part all of the county of Campbell and state of Virginia, witnesseth
that the said Alexander P. Peat and Elizabeth his wife on consideration
of the sum of five hundred dollars lawful money of this Commonwealth
to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Appelwhite at or before the
sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is by both
acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents doth each
of them doth bargain and sell unto him the said Thomas Appelwhite
his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land bounded
as follows to wit Beginning at a pine near a new corner of Peat & Appelwhite
near the road, thence south 78° 40' 50" poles to end of the line thence 70'
to the pole to a black gum, the run of hys branch a corner of Peat &
Peat, thence along the run of said branch the various courses thence to
a pine a corner of Thomas Appelwhite 1 1/2 pole east 33' pole to a
Appelwhite's fence thence 1 1/2 E 13 1/2 pole to a white oak in the ridge
branch a corner of thos Appelwhite and Sally Davis thence along the
run of said branch S 55' E 56' pole to a holly bush a new corner
made between Thomas Appelwhite and Alexander P. Peat thence S 14'
E 14' 8 pole to a pine near the old shoh, a new corner of Thomas
Appelwhite & Alexander P. Peat, thence S 75' E 70' pole to a small
pine a new corner made between Peat and Appelwhite, thence due
south 84' pole to the first station, containing two hundred acres
by the same more or less to have and to hold the (said tract
or parcel of land with the tenements, hereditaments & all and
singular, other the premises herein before mentioned, to be bargained
and sold, and every part and parcel thereof with every of their
rights, members and appurtenances unto the said Thomas
Appelwhite his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only
proper use, and behoof of him the said Thomas Appelwhite
