This Indenture made this 14th day of November in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and eighteen Between William Johnson of Halifax County, (Va.) of the one part and Ann Johnson widow of Edward Johnson of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other party Witnesseth that the said William Johnson for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five dollars to him in hand paid by the said Ann Johnson at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Ann Johnson widow as aforesaid all my right interest claim or demand of a certain tract or parcel of land which fell to me by the death of my brother Edward Johnson who died in the service of the United States to a certain tract or parcel of County Lands lying and being in the Territory of the Illinois, containing one hundred and sixty acres being the north west 1/4 of section thirty four of township thirteen north in Range three east and numbered 10914 together with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the same or any part or parcel thereof to have and to hold the said land with the tenements and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold with every right and member thereof to the said Ann Johnson Widow as aforesaid, to her and her heirs and assigns forever, to and for the only proper use and behoof of her the said Ann Johnson her heirs and assigns forever and
