This Indenture made this 7th day of May one
thousand eight hundred and nineteen, between Drury Williams of the
County of Southampton of the one part, James Cobb of the said County of
the second part (and Eliza Lewis of the said County of Southampton of the
third part, Witnesseth that whereas the said Drury Williams stands
justly indebted by bond to the said James Cobb in the sum of three
hundred and fifty one dollars and eight Cts. current money of the United
States of America and whereas the further assurance of the payment
it is agreed by the parties hereto that a conveyance in trust shall be
made to the said Eliza Lewis, for the benefit of the said James Cobb
in case the said bond shall not be punctually paid off, with lawful
interest thereon on or before the first day of July next then this
Indenture Witnesseth that the said Drury Williams for and in con-
sideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to him in
hand paid, the receipt of which is acknowledged, has bargained, sold
and by these presents doth for himself his heirs, executors and assigns
give, grant bargain and sell unto the said Eliza Lewis his heirs and
assigns, all the plantations, messuages, tenements and parcels of land
now belonging to the said Drury Williams in the County of
Southampton aforesaid, containing by estimation three hundred
and five acres, be the same more or less, bounded according to
the known and reputed bounds thereof; and also all the butternut
