This Indenture

made this the twenty first
day January one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, between the overseers
of the Poor of the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia of the
one part and Peter Edwards of said County of the other part, Witnesseth
that the said overseers as aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum
of three thousand nine hundred and fifty four Dollars and twenty
nine cents, current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said
Peter Edwards, at or before the expiration of twelve months from
the date of these presents the receipt whereof they the said overseers of
the poor as aforesaid doth fully acknowledge themselves fully
satisfied, Contented and paid, have sold, aliened, conveyed & confirmed
by these presents doth grant, sell, convey and forever confirm unto
from the said Peter Edwards his heirs & assigns a certain tract
meadow, plantation, tract, or parcel of land situate lying and
being in the County aforesaid containing by a State survey
four hundred and ninety two and a half acres to the same
more or less, bounded as follows to wit Beginning at the
home meadow branch thence South eighty two degrees east
two hundred pole, thence north sixty eight degrees east forty
