This Indenture made this twenty fourth day of February eighteen hundred and nineteen between Anthony Andrews and Mary his wife of the one part, and Stephen Andrews of the other part, witnesses that for and in consideration of the sum of eighty one dollars to them in hand paid, or otherwise secured before this sealing & delivering these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold, and do by these presents grant bargain, sell, confirm, deliver and confirm unto the said Stephen Andrews one certain well-located parcel of land situate in the County aforesaid, and adjoining the lands of said Anthony Andrews and Etheldred Washington it being a part of the land the said Anthony Andrews now resides on, more or less and bounded as follows. Beginning at a post oak in Etheldred Washington line on a ditch and running S 5 1/2° W 49 1/2 poles (said Washington line, to a black gum a corner, in redoubt branch, thence up the said branch by the meanders thereof to the fork in said Pole, thence up the north prong of said branch by the meanders thereof 40 poles to another fork, thence up the north prong 22 3/4 E 1 1/2 poles to a corner, and thence S 8 1/2° E. 53 3/4 poles to the first station a corner in said Andrews line, containing eighteen acres be the same more or less.
