**This Indenture** made and executed the 21<sup>st</sup>  
 day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
 nineteen Henry Curley of the first part, Edward Reese of the second part  
 and James Britt of the third part all of the County of Hampton and State  
 of Virginia, Witnesseth that whereas the said James Britt by his certain deed  
 dated the day of 1819, and admitted to record in the County Court of  
 Hampton the day of June 1819, in order to secure the payment at that  
 time therein specified of the sum of seven hundred and ten dollars with  
 interest thereon as in the same deed expressed, also the further sum of one  
 hundred and forty dollars, with the accruing interest thereon owing  
 by him the said James Britt to the said Edward Reese, as note to Ralph  
 Shamall the said Reese as security for the said Britt, conveyed in  
 trust to the said Henry Curley of certain tract of land, lying and  
 being in the County aforesaid, containing five hundred and thirty  
 acres, also the following slaves to wit: Mrs. Peter, Moses & Milly, and  
 the said Edward Reese being willing that forty one acre & quarters  
 acres being a part of the said tract of land above conveyed to him  
 be released to the said James Britt the boundaries of which will  
 appear in two deeds from the said James Britt and wife to Henry  
 Gardner, and to Edmunds Cobb, bearing date the day 21<sup>st</sup>  
 of August 1819, and recorded in the County Court of Hampton  
 on the day of 1819, Now this Indenture further witnesseth  
 - that for and in consideration of the premises as also  
 for and in consideration of one dollar by the said James Britt  
 to the said Henry Curley in hand paid before the sealing and  
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 - notwithstanding they the said Henry Curley with the consent of  
 the said Edward Reese signified by his being made a  
 party hereto, have granted, remised, released and forever quit  
 claimed and by these presents do fully and absolutely grant  
 remise, release and forever quit claim unto the said James  
 Britt his heirs and assigns forever the aforesaid forty one &  
 one quarter acres of land, being only a part of the aforesaid
