

The said John Smith by bond bearing date with these presents amounting to twelve hundred and forty seven Dollars, and seventy three cents with the interest which may hereafter accrue upon the same, hath bargained sold aliened enjossed and confirmed and by these presents, doth bargain, sell alien and confirm unto the said James Inghram, one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid situated upon sea beach swamp. Containing three thousand and thirty three acres being the same tract of land which the said Herod Summrell purchased of said John Smith, and upon which the said Herod Summrell now resides to have and to hold to the said parcel or tract of land together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto unto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said James Inghram his heirs and assigns forever, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said James Inghram his heirs and assigns forever, notwithstanding the special trust and confidence, that he shall upon application of the said John Smith after giving four weeks public notice by advertisement at the door of the Court house of this County of Southampton aforesaid proceed to sell at public auction for ready money at the Court House aforesaid the aforesaid tract of land with the proceeds of the sale to pay and satisfy first the costs attending the execution of this trust and then the debt and interest aforesaid, which may then be due to the said John Smith also much thereof as the same may be due and if any balance should remain after paying costs attending the execution of the trust and the debt and interest aforesaid, he shall pay the same to the said Herod Summrell his executor or administrators.
