 year of the Commonwealth, Between Joseph S. Hland & Elizabeth his wife
 of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia, of the one part, and
 the Rivers of S. County and state of the other part. Witnesseth that the
 said Joseph S. Hland and Elizabeth his wife in consideration of the
 sum of three hundred dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth
 to them in hand paid by the said Mrs. Rivers, of or before the writing
 and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have bargained and sold and by these presents do (and each of them doth
 bargain and sell unto the said Mrs. Rivers his heirs and assigns a
 certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid
 County of Southampton containing the intimated & stated acres more
 or less adjoining the lands of Mr. Hland, sent her the south and
 west John S. Hland's land and the St. Mary and S. Rivers land
 on the east with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto
 belonging to have and to hold the said bargain and sold
 land unto him the said John Rivers his heirs and assigns
 forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him
 the said Mrs. Rivers his heirs and assigns forever and the
 said Joseph S. Hland for himself his heirs and assigns the
 said bargain and sold land with all and singular the
 premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto
