made this 7th day of January

in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and nineteen between Polly Williams widow and relict of Nathan Williams dec^d of the County and parish of saint Luke of the one part and Lewis Wornell of the same County and parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Polly Williams for and in consideration of the sum of thirty three Dollars and 24 cts current money of Virginia to her in hand paid by the said Lewis Wornell the receipt of the said Polly Williams doth acknowledge herself fully and amply satisfied and paid hath granted, bargain, sold aliened, conveyed, confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey, confirm unto the said Lewis Wornell to him and to his heirs forever, all the right, title, interest claim or demand whatsoever, that she the said Polly Williams has in a certain tract or parcel of land that Nathan Williams her said husband sold to the said Wornell in his life which deed is duly recorded in the County Court of Southampton, and by having reference to a Deed well fully delineate the bounds of the said land expressed here and the said Polly Williams widow of the said Nathan Williams dec^d did not execute or did in his life time, which tract of Land contained thirty seven more or less and bounded well fully appear by referring the deed aforesaid together with the houses, out houses, edifices, buildings, yards, gardens, orchards, ways, waters and water courses
