eight hundred and nineteen in the forty third year of the Commonwealth
Between John Rivers of Southampton County and state of Virginia of the
one part and Joseph Glau of said County and state of the other part
Witnesseth that the said John Rivers in consideration of the sum of three hundred
dollars of lawful money in this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by
the said Joseph Glau at or before the making and delivery of these
presented the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and
sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph
Glau his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing
by a late survey forty eight and a half acres more or less
bounded as follows to wit on the north by David Montbrook's line
on the south by Isaac Ramsay's line, on the east by said Rivers
land purchased of Joshua Glau being a part of said land &c
the west by the land of said Joseph Glau together with
all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging
