

324 20th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & eighteen between the said Clement Rocher and Nancy his wife proprietors vendors of said two acres of land and the said Justice of the Peace, of the one part and Henry Clanton of the other part witnesseth that the said Clement Rocher and the said Justice as already for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars to the said Clement Rocher in hand paid by the said Henry Clanton at and before the making and delivery of this present, the receipt whereof the said Clement Rocher doth hereby acknowledge and forever acquit and discharge the said Henry Clanton of the same have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed and by this present Clanton this lot in the said town of Henrico, known in the plan of said town by numbers 27, 28, & 29 containing each one half acre & bounded as follows to wit Lot No 27 a corner bounded by Catherine's street and Lot No 28 the first lot in the stop of the street on Jefferson street nearly opposite Henry Melb's garden lot together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, to have and to hold the said lot with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Henry Clanton his heirs & assigns forever and the said Clement Rocher doth hereby for himself his heirs & assigns forever and agree to and with the said Henry Clanton his heirs and assigns to warrant and defend the right and title in and to the said lots against the claim or claims, demands or demands of all and every person whatsoever.
