and nineteen between Robert Daughtry and Tabitha his wife of the County of West
Virginia of the one part and Lewis Morris of the same County of the
other. Witnesseth that the said Robert Daughtry and Tabitha his wife
for and in consideration of the sum of twenty two dollars & fifty cents to them
in hand paid by the said Lewis Morris at or before the sealing and delivering
of these presents the receipt whereof the said Robert Daughtry and Tabitha his
wife both hereby acknowledge and thereby acquit and discharge that Lewis
Morris his heirs and assigns forever by these presents they the said
Robert Daughtry and Tabitha his wife have granted, sold, conveyed and
aliened, released and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, sell, alien
release and confirm unto the said Lewis Morris and his heirs and assigns
forever a tract or parcel of land lying and being on the south side of
Potomac River in the County aforesaid, and in the parish of Saint Luke
Containing Four and a half acres be the same more or less and bounded
as followeth, to wit. Beginning at a Hickory in Lewis Morris line
a corner of Josiah Forgans line about 21 poles to a lighted post, thence a
straight line about 64 poles to a pine in said Morris line about 69 poles to
the beginning with all woods and underwoods trees, mays, not in water courses
low grounds, meadows, pastures, commodities and appurtenances whatsoever
belonging to the said tract or parcel of land and premises to the only
proper use and behoof of the said Lewis Morris his heirs and assigns forever
and the said Robert Daughtry and Tabitha his wife for themselves, their heirs
executors and assigns do hereby covenant and grant to and with the said Lewis
Morris his heirs and assigns in manner and form following that is to
say, that the said Lewis Morris his heirs and assigns shall and may
at all times forever hereafter peaceably have hold and occupy possess
all and singular the said Four and a half acres of land and
premises as above mentioned with the appurtenances without the
