This Indenture made this 1st day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty between Nathaniel Boush and Sarah E his wife of the first part, the President Directors and Company of the Steam Navigation Company of the second part, and Alexander Jordan of the third part who have been mutually bound by the other parties hereto. In witness whereof the said Nathaniel Boush is indebted to the said President Directors and Company in the just & full sum of seven thousand, eight hundred & thirty seven dollars and seventy two cents which sum he the said Nathaniel Boush is willing and desirous to secure unto them the said President Directors and Company in the most effectual manner. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Nathaniel Boush and Sarah E his wife for & in consideration of the premises and for and in the further consideration of the sum of five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Alexander Jordan at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed released & confirmed and let these presents do grant bargain sell alien convey release & confirm unto him the said Alexander Jordan his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton in the south side of Potomack river on the back of road being the same piece or tract of land that was conveyed by James Miller and Martha his wife to the said Nathaniel Boush by deed bearing date the first of Nov: one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, all which will more fully appear by reference to the said deed now of record in the Court of the County aforesaid also a lot piece parcel of land situate lying & being in the borough of Norfolk and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a stake or stone on the east side of Botetout Street and on the south side of William Christopher Raines's line thence running and binding on said line North eighty seven degrees east one hundred feet thence South three degrees east one hundred feet thence South eighty seven degrees west one hundred feet thence South Botetout Street thence North three degrees west one hundred feet and ending at said Street to the beginning
