This Indenture made and entered into this 30 day of April in the  
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteenth between  
Henry and Fanny his wife of the County of Southampton (and State of  
Virginia) of the one part and Polly Brister of the County of Suffolk  
of the other part of the State of Virginia. Brister of the other part doth  
testify that the said Henry and Fanny his wife for and in consideration  
sum of six hundred Dollars to them for hand paid by the said Polly  
Brister at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the  
receipt whereof is hereby by the said Henry and Fanny his  
wife acknowledged unto the said Polly Brister and her heirs assigns  
are by this Indenture acquitted and forever discharged have bargained  
and sold and doth by these presents grant bargain sell assign forever  
confirm unto the said Polly Brister and her heirs executors administrators  
of Certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of  
Suffolk aforesaid and State of Virginia aforesaid. Containing the  
following description to wit: beginning at a white oak a corner between said  
tract of land and said Henry and Fanny standing by the side of the  
long branch thence down said branch to a forest gum a corner  
between Dr. Lowe. James Clayton and said land thence a line of marked  
trees between Dr. Clayton Phillips Rancher. Same line to the  
road thence down said road to the beginning to have and to hold  
the said tract or parcel of land with fees and singular the appurte-  
nances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the  
only proper use and behoof of her the said Polly Brister and her  
heirs executors administrators forever with the reversion provisions  
remainder and remainder unto fees and profits thereof with every  
part or parcel thereof together with the houses out houses gardens  
ways, waters and matters coming to the only proper use of her the said  
Polly Brister and her heirs executors administrators forever and the said Henry and  
Fanny his wife doth by these presents warrant forever defend the  
right and title of said land and premises to the said Polly Brister  
and her heirs executors administrators forever free from the claims or  
demands of them the said Henry and Fanny his wife or from  
any other person or persons claiming the said land and premises  
of any part or parcel thereof in witness whereof they the said  
Henry and Fanny his wife doth hereunto set their  
hand and affix their seals the day & date above mentioned, Signed
