Turner executor of Mr Francis dec'd of the one part and Sally Francis
of the other part Whereas the said Mr Francis by his last will &
testament of record in the court of the county of Southampton
directed certain lands therein mentioned to be sold by virtue
thereof hath as the said directs, sold to the highest bidder
a certain part of the said land of which the said Sally
Francis became the purchaser. Now this indenture witnesseth
that the said James Turner executor as aforesaid in consideration
of the sum of nineteen hundred and twenty dollars to him in
hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath given
granted, bargained and sold, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed
and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell alien
and enfeoff and confirm unto the said Sally Francis her
heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of
land lying in the county of Southampton and parish of
Saint Luke containing by a late survey two
hundred and forty acres more or less & bounded as
