This Indenture made this 31st day of May in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and nineteenth between Robert A. Rogers of the
County of Southampton of the one part and J^r Travis of the County of Harris of
the other part all witnesses, that the Robert A. Rogers for consideration
of the sum of twenty dollars lawful money of the United States to him
then and paid by the said J^r Travis before the executing & delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof to the said Robert A. Rogers doth fully
acknowledge, thereof agree every part and parcel thereof doth fully
clearly and absolutely acquit exonerate & discharge the said J^r Travis
his heirs assigns and all persons from and for damages costs and charges &
controversies then & to come moving to the said Robert A. Rogers hath
granted bargain'd and sold alien'd enfeoff'd and confirm'd & by these
presents fully himself his heirs and assigns do grant bargain'd sell
alien enfeoff confirm unto the said J^r Travis his heirs assigns
power of attorney certain tract or parcel of land containing two acres
being a part of a tract of land being by the said Robert A. Rogers
by the death of Allen Rogers and having as followeth to wit
Beginning at a pine corner tree of Willis Wellens in Brittons
Travis line thence along the said Travis line n 2 m. twenty pole
to a pine then a new line between the said Robert A. Rogers and
J^r Travis, n 66 e. 16 pole to a lightwood post then S 22 E 20 pole to
a small oak in Willis Wellens line then S by m 16 pole to the
beginning To have and to hold the lands hereby conveyed
all and singular the premises herein before mentioned and
intended to be hereby granted with the divisions and revisions
remainders and reversioners rents and services of the premises
also all the estate rights title interest claims & demands
of him the said Robert A. Rogers his heirs and assigns of
in or to the said land and premises and every part thereof
with the appurtenances herein before mentioned unto the said
J^r Travis his heirs and assigns forever of the said Robert A. Rogers for
himself his heirs from all persons or persons whatsoever claiming
or demanding the said premises doth hereby warrant of power defend unto the
said J^r Travis his heirs & assigns to the only proper person & his heirs the said
his heirs and assigns forever in witness whereof the said Robert A. Rogers hath
hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year first above written, signed
