At a Court held for the County of Southampton the day of November 1819
This Indenture made & acknowledged by Jno D. Powell Esq Esq of the
parties hitherto and now to be hereinafter mentioned.

This Indenture made this 30th day of May in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, between Robert A. Rogers of the
County of Southampton of the one part and Joe Travis of the County of Suffolk
of the other part aforesaid, that the said Robert A. Rogers for consideration
of the sum of twenty dollars lawful money of the United States to him
in hand paid by the said Joe Travis before the making & delivery of this
present, the receipt whereof to the said Robert A. Rogers doth hereby
acknowledged, thereof and every part and parcel thereof doth fully
clearly and absolutely acquit & exonerate to discharge the said Travis
his heirs & executors by this present and for ever from all good causes &
considerations then & present moving to the said Robert A. Rogers hath
granted bargained and sold a land aforesaid and confirmed by these
presents himself his heirs and successors do grant, bargain and sell
also aforesaid aforesaid unto the said Joe Travis his heirs & executors
forever an certain tract or parcel of land containing two acres
being a part of a tract of land held by the said Robert A. Rogers
by the death of Allen Rogers and bounded as followeth to wit
Beginning at a pine corner tree of Willis Willows in Britton
Travis line, thence along the said Travis line w. 2 m. twenty pole
to a pine then a new line between the said Robert A. Rogers and
Joe Travis, w. 66 e. 16 pole to a litchford post then 5 1/2 E 20 pole to
a small oak in Willis Willows line then 5 1/2 e. 16 pole to the
beginning to have and to hold the lands hereby conveyed
all and singular the premises herein before mentioned and
intended to be hereby granted with the house and buildings
remained and relictures, rents and services of the premises
also all the estate right title interest claims & demands
of him the said Robert A. Rogers his heirs and executors
of or to the said land and premises and every part thereof
with the appurtenances herein before mentioned unto the said
Joe Travis his heirs and executors forever of the sum of Robert A. Rogers to
himself his heirs from all & every other person or persons whatsoever claiming
or demanding the said land & premises doth hereby warrant & forever defend unto the
said Joe Travis his heirs & executors to the only proper & undivided part of the same the said
Robert A. Rogers his heirs and executors In witness whereof the said Robert A. Rogers hath
hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year first above written, signed
and delivered in presence of us
