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This Indenture

Made this second day of
 the first part Spratly Williams of the second part & Henry S. P. Westbrooks of
 the third part. Whereas the said Thomas Bittle is justly indebted to the said
 Henry S. P. Westbrooks in the sum of three hundred and forty six dollars and
 thirty Cents as his bond bearing date this second day of March 1818
 more fully appears, which debt with the legal interest thereon accruing
 the said Thomas Bittle is willing and desirous of securing. Now this
 Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the promises & also
 for the further sum of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the
 said Thomas Bittle in hand paid by the said Spratly Williams at and
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged he the said Thomas Bittle hath given, granted
 bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, released and confirmed and by these
 presents doth give, grant, bargain, sell alien, convey, release & confirm
 to the said Spratly Williams his heirs and assigns forever all that
 tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton in
 the State of Virginia containing sixty eight and three fourths acres be
 the same more or less and bounded by the lands of the est of Benjⁿ
 Lewis, John Nicholson, Benjamin Applewhite, Francis Leathen and
 Charlotte Westbrooks (free negro) with all and singular the appurtenances
 to the said tract of land belonging or in anywise appurtenant and
 all the estate, right, title and interest of the said Thomas Bittle in and
 to the said granted or intended to be granted tract or parcel of land
 and premises. To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended
 to be granted tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances
 unto the said Spratly Williams his heirs executors and assigns
 forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Spratly
 Williams his heirs executors and assigns forever and the said
 Thomas Bittle for himself his heirs executors and assigns doth hereby covenant
 promise and agree to and with the said Spratly Williams his
 heirs executors and assigns forever in manner and form following
 that is to say that the said Thomas Bittle his heirs executors and assigns
 shall the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with
 their appurtenances unto the said Spratly Williams his heirs
