 year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, by between
 Richard Murphy of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the
 first part Carr Powers of the same County and State of the second part and
 Cynthia Haden of the same County of the third part, Witnesseth that whereas
 the said Carr Powers has become security for the payment of a debt of two
 hundred and eighty six dollars, and twenty six cents, which is due owing
 from the said Richard Murphy to Capt Haden of the said County, as appears
 by a note duly executed by them the said Richard Murphy and Carr Powers
 to the said Capt Haden for the sum aforesaid which note bears
 equal date with these presents and is made payable on or before the
 first day of January next. And whereas the said Carr Powers has also
 become security for a debt due and owing from the said Richard Murphy
 to Martha Lawrence of the County of Stafford right as appears by note
 duly executed by the said Richard Murphy and Carr Powers to the said
