This Indenture made this 20th day of October the year christ one thousand eight hundred and nineteen between William P. Erwinth and his wife Maria of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Littlebury Mason of the same County and State of the second, Witnesseth that the said William P. Erwinth & Maria his wife for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred thirty three dollars have bargained sold, affirmed, enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto the said Littlebury Mason a certain parcel of land, situate, holden & enjoyed six acres more or less of which the late John L. Wilkerson died seized which has descended to the said William P. Erwinth by the death of Ann Maria Wilkerson an infant child of the said John L. Wilkerson dec'd also one undivided ninth part of that portion of the same tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia on Meherrin river which was attested and assigned to Ann Maria widow of the said John L. Wilkerson dec'd as and for her dower, to have and to hold the aforesaid parcels of land with all the profits, Commodities and issues and all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said Mason his heirs and assigns forever, to have and to hold free from all hindrance, incumbrance whatsoever and the said Erwinth and wife for themselves their heirs, executors & assigns hereby covenant and agree with the said Mason that they will forever warrant and defend this right and title to the said land herein conveyed to the said Mason & his heirs against the claim or claims of all person or persons whatsoever.
