This Indenture made this 17th day of December in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, between Richard Harrison, Jr.
 of Southampton County of the one part and Thomas Harrison Senr of the
 said County of the second part, and Benjamin Turner of the County aforesaid
 of the third part. Witnesseth, that whereas the said Thomas Harrison Senr
 becoming bound with the said Richard Harrison Senr for the maintenance
 of a certain suit appealed from the superior Court of Southampton County
 to the Chancery Court of Williamsburg, whereas Henry Briggs admr. of
 Henry Smith, and the said Richard Harrison Senr saw defendant said
 whereas for the further assurances (and securing) it is agreed by the
 said Richard Harrison Jr and Thomas Harrison Senr as aforesaid that a
 conveyance in trust shall be made by the said Benjamin Turner
 for the benefit of the said Thomas Harrison Senr. Now this Indenture
 therefore witnesseth that the said Richard Harrison Senr for and in consideration
 of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, and sold aliened, released and
 confirmed, and by these doth for himself his heirs execs and assigns, grant
 bargain and sell make over and confirm unto the said Benjamin Turner
 and to his heirs execs, admrs and assigns, one tract of land whereon
 I now reside, containing by estimation two hundred and forty two and
 one half acres also one other tract whereon my son Richard now
 resides, containing by estimation two hundred and thirty acres, lie the
 same more or less, to have and to hold the aforesaid tracts of land
 unto him the said Benj. Turner his heirs and assigns on trust, neverthe-
 less and upon this express condition, that if the said Richard
 Harrison Senr his heirs execs and assigns shall perpetually pay the
 debt and cost of the said suit, if defeated, if not then the said
 Benjamin
