 Harrison for aforesaid his heirs assigns, he the said Benjamin Turner his
 executors assigns or either of them shall give twenty days
 notice in the town of Jerusalem and at any public place in
 the neighbourhood shall proceed to sell at public sale the above
 tract of land or as much thereof as will be sufficient to discharge
 the said debt and cost if defaulted as aforesaid also the legal charges
 for recording this Indenture and shall pay the money arising
 therefrom to the said Thomas Harrison or his heirs assigns
 so far as shall be then due, and after satisfying the said debt and
 costs and charges aforesaid shall pay the surplus money to the said
