

last past, and the other the eighteenth day of June last past, and are all made payable the fourth day of December next ensuing, where as the said Joshua Gardner is willing and desirous to secure and guard his said security, against all and every possible suffering payment of money or other damage or inconvenience, which might accrue to him for or on account of these several securityships or either of them, Now therefore he the said Joshua Gardner for the Considerations aforesaid, but especially for and in consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Sipe Parker at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, he the said Joshua Gardner for himself his heirs, executors and assigns hath granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell, confirm unto him the said Sipe Parker and to his heirs and assigns forever the following negro slaves to wit a negro man Aaron and a woman named Beck and their children to wit, Aaron, Amey and Nelson. To have and to hold the negro slaves aforesaid to him the said Sipe Parker his heirs and assigns forever, Upon the following trust, VIZ that if the said Joshua Gardner shall so neglect, refuse or delay the payment of the before mentioned debts or either of them, that of suit or suits shall be commenced, and process of law be served on him the said Henry Gardner or his heirs, executors or administrators, for the recovery thereof, that so soon as such an event shall happen and the said Sipe Parker shall be there duly notified, he the said Sipe Parker shall immediately proceed to advertise and sell to the highest bidder for ready money, such and so many of the slaves aforesaid as shall be sufficient to discharge the debt or debts so due for, and having made such sale shall pay the money in discharge of such debt or debts and the trouble and expenses incident to this present trust, and if the whole of the debts are not in the first instance due for, but shall remain due, he the said Sipe Parker shall proceed in like manner as after as suits shall be brought and process served as aforesaid untill the whole of the said debts shall be discharged together with the expenses and trouble attached to the business, and if after all the debts with their growing interest shall be discharged and himself satisfied and paid for his trouble, any surplus money shall remain in the hands of the said Sipe Parker he shall pay it over to the said Joshua Gardner or to his heirs, executors or administrators.
