This Indenture made this second day of August in
 the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and nineteen, between Edwin
 Drake and Sally, his wife of the County of Southampton State of
 Virginia of the one part and Silas Vick of the aforesaid County of
 the other part, Witnesseth that the said Edwin Drake and Sally, his
 wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and
 fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Silas Vick at or
 before the signing, sealing and delivring of these presents, the
 receipt whereof the said Edwin Drake and Sally his wife doth
 hereby acknowledge and themselves fully satisfied and paid
 have bargained, sold, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents
 doth hereby ^{bargain} ~~grant~~ sell, alien, and forever confirm unto the said Silas
 Vick his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying
 being ^{situate} in the County of Sampton in the parish of Wottonay adjoining
 the lands of Elbert Williams John Williams. Edwin Drake Joseph
 Vick John Drake and Walter orphans, containing seventy two
 and a half acres more or less, bounded by the most known
 antient and reputed bounds thereof being one half or the
 supposed one half of the tract of land devised by Matthew
 Vick sen. ^{deceased} to his sons Joel and Joel Vick that he purchased
 of Hardy Johnson also a certain part of that plantation tract and
 parcel of land that the said Edwin Drake purchased of the said
 situate lying and being in the County and state aforesaid containing
 by estimation six acres or the same more or less and bounded as
 follows to wit beginning at a pine in the line of the said Williams
 line standing on the north side of the road leading from Thomas
 Camps to Wottonay swamp thence along said Williams
 line to the aforesaid Edwin Drake's line thence along said
 Drake's line to the aforesaid road thence along said road to
 the beginning to have and to hold the said tracts or
 parcels of land with all the tenements thereunto
 belonging or in any wise appertaining unto
 the said Silas Vick his heirs and assigns forever
 with all the reversion and reversions remaining
