Carolina of the one part and George Whitfield of the County of Sampson and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars by the said George Whitfield in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Anderson Edwards hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain, sell, alien and confirm unto him the said George Whitfield all right title property and interest in and to the divided and undivided parts of the land and the undivided part of the personal estate which may fall to me of my father Jacob Edwards dec'd and Mary Edwards his relict. He have and to have the said property both real and personal to him the said George Whitfield as a his heirs forever and he the said Anderson Edwards for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth by these presents warrant
