This Indenture

20th day of July one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, between Nathan Edwards and Sedidah his wife of the County of Southampton^{made this}
State of Virginia of the one part and Lewis Worrell of the same
County and State of the other party Witneseth that the sd Nathan
Edwards and Sedidah his wife for and in consideration of the
sum of one hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said
Lewis Worrell at or before the sealing and delivering of these
presents the receipt whereof the said Nathan Edwards & Sedidah
wife doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit & discharge
the said Lewis Worrell his heirs executors and administrators forever by their
presents they the said Nathan Edwards & Sedidah his wife have
granted bargained sold alienated released and confirmed, and by these
presents do grant sell alien release and confirm unto the said Lewis
Worrell his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel
of land lying and being in the County aforesaid containing
Seventeen acres one half acres and Leavelups as follows, to wit
beginning at a lightwood post a corner of Peterson Edwards
near his house in Lewis Worrells line, thence along s^E Edwards
line to the run of the little swamp in Lewis Worrells line, then
down the run of said swamp to the fork a corner of the down
of Mary Edwards, thence up the prong of said swamp along
downline to a black gum another corner of the above in Lewis
Worrells line, thence along the said Worrells line to the beginning
with all woods, trees, waters waters and water courses, profit
commodities and appurtenances whatsoever belonging to the tract
belonging or in any way appertaining thereto and the sole & undivided possession
or parcel of land and appurtenances to the only proper use & benefit of
the said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever and the sd Nathan
Edwards and Sedidah his wife for themselves their heirs executors
and assigns to the said Lewis Worrell his heirs executors &c. and may at all time forever
hereafter peaceably hold and occupy the same all and singular
the said Seventeen and one half acres of land and premises as above
mentioned with the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said Lewis
Worrell & the said Nathan Edwards & Sedidah his wife for themselves their
heirs executors, administrators &c. for ever warrant & defend the title of the
same and every part thereof against all and singular persons or persons
whatever and notwithstanding the sd Nathan Edwards & Sedidah his wife
hath hereto set their hands & affixed their seals the day and date first
