Southampton County for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred & sixty one
dollars to me in hand paid by Elizabeth M. Collier of the same County first and
before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof I do hereby
acknowledge have bargained sold granted and confirmed and by these presents
do bargain sell grant and confirm to the said Eliz. M. Collier all my right and
title in the personal estate and the following slaves to wit. Saml. Will. Hester
Henry, Fanny, and Anna her child which said slaves and personal estate was
assigned to my mother the said Eliz. M. Collier as her dower right in and to
the estate of my deceased father Mordey Collier together with the future
increase of the female slaves aforesaid. nless all my right and title in
and to the following slaves to wit Becks, Mary Jacob, Bob Henderson
and Atlas from the future increase of the female slaves aforesaid. which said
slaves belong to the estate of my deceased father Mordey Collier and are
now depending for the same by garnet and other process of North
Carolina to the only proper use and behoof of the said Eliz. M. Collier her
executors, admrs and assigns forever and I the said Thomas R. Collier for myself my
executors and admrs the said slaves aforesaid to the said Eliz. M. Collier her executors
administration and assigns against me the said Thomas R. Collier my executors and
assigns and against all and every other person or persons whosoever shall or will
warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof I have hereunto

sealing and delivery of these presents have bargained and sold
unto the said Benjamin Weaver his heirs and assigns forever a certain
tract or parcel of land lying and being in the Territory of
Illinois containing by estimation one hundred and sixty acres
being the north west of Section thirty four of Township
