This Indenture made and executed this 4th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty between Giles Russ and Nancy J Russ his wife of the County of Southampton of the first part, Benjamin Cobb, Jeremiah Cobb, John J Blaw Henry Welsh & Thos Fitzgerald Trustees for the Nottoway and Sassemone tribes of Indians and for and in behalf and for the benefit of the said Nottoway Indians of the County of Southampton of the second part and James Truistart of the County of Southampton of the third part Witnesseth that whereas by an act of the General Assembly of Virginia authorizing and empowering the said Trustees or a majority of them to make sale of a certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation eleven hundred and twenty four and five eighths acres belonging to the said tribes of Indians which passed the 12th day of January 1820. amendatory of the act passed the 30th day of January 1819. and the said trustees showing taken upon themselves to discharge the duties imposed upon them by the said first vested act of Assembly. by and with the consent of the said tribes of Indians did on the 4th day of March 1820 impose to sale two hundred and eighty one acres of land being one fourth part part of the said tract authorized to be sold by the said act of Assembly which requires the same to be divided and sold in four separate tracts, Where Giles Russ being the highest bidder, became the purchaser of the said tract of land for the sum of fourteen hundred and seven dollars and eighty one cents and the said Giles Russ being indebted to the said Trustees by the purchase aforesaid in the sum of one thousand and fifty five dollars and eighty six cents being the fourth of the purchase money which is to be paid in three annual installments as follows Vist the sum of three hundred and fifty one dollars and ninety five cents to be paid to the said trustees for their receipts on the 4th day of March 1821. the sum of three hundred and fifty one dollars and ninety five cents on the 4th day of March 1822. and the sum of three hundred and fifty one dollars and ninety five cents on the 4th day of March 1823.
