this second day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred &
ninety by and between John Barnett of the County of Southampton and State of
Virginia of the first part and Edwin Beale and Lewis Worrell of the second
part and Jacob Barnes of the third part. Whereas the said John Barnett
stands justly indebted unto the said Edwin Beale and Lewis Worrell the
sum off (say) Edwin Beale one hundred dollars, Lewis Worrell one
hundred and forty four dollars and fifty cents by bonds of even date
these presents in demand, E. Beale October 15th & L. W. two days after
date the payment of which together with the interest shall accrue
thence the said John Barnett is willing and desirous to secure the said
Indenture. Witnesseth that the said John Barnett as well for consideration
of the premises as for the sum of one dollar current money of the State
to him in hand paid by the said Jacob Barnes at and before the
executing and delivery of these presents the full receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged just from every part of which the said Jacob
Barnes all and his legal representatives are forever released and
exonerated and discharged, have granted bargained and sold and do
hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said Jacob Barnes his
heirs and assigns as followeth, one tract or parcel of land lying &
being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by estimation
eighty two acres more or less, the being the plantation whereon now
reside and ^{formerly} William Newsums Samuel Vicks Holladay Reville. The
said lands to have and to hold the before mentioned tract
of land and all the right therein to the said Jacob Barnes
