and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Valentine
Branch and Wilmoth doth hereby acknowledge, thereof and every
part and parcel thereof doth fully, clearly and absolutely acquit
exonerate and discharge the said Lewis M. Branch his heirs, executors
and assigns by these presents and for divers of other good causes &
consideration them therunto moving they the said Valentine
Branch and Wilmoth his wife, have granted, bargained & sold
aliened, enfeoffed and conveyed and they their presents for themselves
their heirs & successors do grant, bargain and sell, alien, enfeoff and
confirm unto Lewis M. Branch his heirs and assigns forever one
certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and
ninety nine acri. more or less, being a tract of land hereafter
