This Indenture made this 21st day of February in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty between Nathan Porter of the one part and of the County of Solomons and State of North Carolina and Joseph Pope of the other part and of the County of Sampson State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Nathan Porter for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Pope at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Nathan Porter hath hereunto set his hand and seal and confirmed unto the said Joseph Pope his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or divided of land situate lying and being in the County of Sampson and State of Virginia lying on the South side of Robt day river and containing by estimation thirty two acres and two thirds of an acre less the same more or less. It being a proportionable part of the land formerly belonging to James Porter dec'd and bounded as followeth, to wit, beginning at a red oak corner tree between
