This Indenture made this 1st day of September in the year eighteen hundred and twenty, between Joshua Nicholson of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the one part and Littleton Williamson of the County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joshua Nicholson being fully indebted to Arthur Williamson of said County in the sum of Nine hundred and ninety one Dollars and 11¹/₄ Cent Virginia money duly bound with lawful interest from this date and being willing and desirous to secure the payment of the said sum to the said Arthur Williamson in consideration whereof moreover for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged the said Joshua Nicholson hath given granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth give grant bargain, sell and make over unto the said Littleton Williamson his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County of Southampton Virginia and bounded as follows by the 76 Drury on the east and on the north by the three Cuts, and on the south by the lands of the orphans of John Shippey with all and singular the appurtenances also one boy man to labor and to hold the said tract or parcel of land unto the said Littleton Williamson his heirs and assigns forever in trust for said Littleton Williamson his heirs &c for the express purpose of paying off the said Arthur Williamson the sum of Nine hundred and ninety one Dollars 11¹/₄ cents Virginia money in case the said Joshua Nicholson should make default therein it is hereby agreed and declared to be the true intent and meaning of this Indenture that if the said sum as above specified be not paid unto the said Arthur Williamson with all interest thereon on or before the 25th
