

25th December next ensuing the date hereof then the said Joshua Williamson shall be at full liberty at any time thereafter when it may suit him the said debt or any part thereof still remaining unpaid to request and compel the said Littleton Williamson to take into his possession all the property specified in this deed and after advertising the time and place of sale for at least ten days at three public places convenient to the residence of said Joshua Nicholson to sell for ready money all the said property contained in this deed or so much as may be sufficient to answer the purpose herein specified and the said Littleton Williamson shall have full power and authority to make over in writing a lawful title and title to the said purchaser or purchasers of said property and the said Joshua Nicholson his heirs and assigns shall be forever stopped from setting up any claim to the same either in Law or equity and the money arising from such sales first to be applied to the payment of the sum due the said Littleton Williamson with all interest and costs thereon accruing and the balance if any to be paid unto the said Joshua Nicholson his heirs executors or to the person or persons entitled to receive the same by the statute of distribution provided always and be it remembered that if the said Joshua Nicholson pay the said sum of money with all interest and costs thereon at any time before the said property be sold in manner as mentioned before then this Indenture to be void and all right interest and title therein conveyed shall revert in the said Joshua Nicholson his heirs and assigns forever.
