 shall by any ways or means hereafter have claim challenge or
 demand any estate right title or interest of in or to the said
 premises or any part or parcel thereof but from all and every action
 for the recovery thereof and from all and every estate right title
 interest or demand of in or to the said premises or any part
 thereof they and every of them shall be utterly excluded and
