made and entered into this  
15th day of September one thousand eight hundred & twenty by between  
Nathan Pope of the County of Hampton of the first part, & Henry  
Gurley of the same County of the second part & George Gurley executor  
of the last will and testament of Josiah Vick dec'd of the third  
part and whereas the said Josiah Vick in his lifetime became  
security to the said Nathan Pope in the following instances  
to wit in a bond or specialty with encumbrances joint to a  
certain James Scott for the sum of one hundred fourteen dollars  
fourteen cents dated on the 20th day of April 1807 payable  
on demand, also a bond or specialty to a certain James Scott  
for the sum of thirty four dollars and thirty three cents dated  
on the 28th day of April 1812 payable on demand the  
said Nathan Pope being willing and desirous to secure and  
incumbrance the estate of the said Josiah Vick from all danger  
of having money to advance for him in the several cases  
above mentioned or either of them Now therefore this indenture  
witnesseth that the said Nathan Pope for and in consideration  
of the premises but more especially for and in consideration  
of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said  
Henry Gurley at and before the unsealing and delivery of  
these presents the full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
and from part of which the said Henry Gurley and all his  
legal representatives are forever exonerated & discharged  
Nath granted bargained, sold, aliened, transferred, conveyed  
& doth hereby grant bargain, sell, alien, transfer, convey & confirm  
unto the said Henry Gurley his heirs and assigns that well known  
tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the  
County of Hampton, and parish of Holloway within the  
said Nathan Pope at present live containing by known
