Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said George Whitfield the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Peterson Edwards hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto him the said George Whitfield all right title interest and estate which he the said Peterson Edwards hath in and to the downer lands and slaves allotted to Mary Edwards as her free downer assigned to her by the Commissioners appointed to lay off and set apart the same.
