whereas by an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia passed the 13th day
of January 1820 to amend the act passed the 30th day of January 1819 con-
cerning the Motomay and Nansamond Tribes of Indians the said Trustees or a
majority of them by and with the consent of the said Indians and authorized
to lay off and make sale of eleven hundred and ninety four and four
eighths acres of land in the County of Southampton adjoining to the Motomay
tribe of Indians first dividing the same into four equal tracts and the said
Trustees or a majority of them in by the said first aforesaid Act authorized
empowered to join the said tribe of Indians in conveying the said lands to the
purchaser or purchasers thereof in fee and whereas the said Trustees with the
assistance of the County Surveyor have laid off by proper miles and bearing
aforesaid tract of land into four tracts as near equally as was practicable and
having advertised the same according to the provisions of the said act
