This Indenture Sheweth that made and executed this 4th day
 of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
 between Thomas Ridley and Nancy his wife of the County of Southampton of
 the first part Benjamin Cobb Esquire and John & John Henry Fish
 and Thomas Fitzhugh Trustee for the Potomac and Patuxent Indians of
 Indians and for and in behalf of the said Potomac Indians of the County
 of Southampton of the second part and James Tregant of the County aforesaid
 of the third part Witnesseth that whereas by an act of the General Assembly
 of Virginia Authorizing and imposing the said Trustee or a Majority of
 them to make sale of a certain tract of Land lying and being in the County of
 Southampton containing by estimation Eleven hundred and twenty four and
 five Eights Acres belonging to the Potomac Indians which passed
 the 12th day of January 1820 Annulment of the act passed the 20th day of
 January 1820 And the said Trustee having taken upon themselves to discharge
 the duties imposed upon them by the said first recited act of Assembly
 by and with the consent of the said Tribe of Indians do on the 4th day
 of March 1820 propose to public sale Ten hundred and Eighty one acres of Land
 being one fourth part of the said tract Authorized to be sold by the said act of
 Assembly which requires the same to be divided and sold in four separate tracts
 when Thomas Ridley being the highest bidder became the purchaser of
 the said tract of Land for the sum of Eleven hundred and twenty four dollars
 and the said Thomas Ridley being indebted to the said Trustee and then
 due upon by the purchase aforesaid in the sum of Eight hundred and forty
 three dollars being three fourths of the purchase money which is to be
 paid in three annual installments as follows Viz The sum of Two hundred
 and Eighty one dollars to be paid to the said Trustee on the 1st day of
 December
