This Indenture Inpartible made and entered into the
 14th day of March 1820 Between Settlers Schollar East Turner Anna
 Morison Mummy Morison James Bartlett Henry Turner Henry Morison
 John Morison Polly Morison Cornelia Polomart Bartlett William Morison
 Alexander Redden and Nancy Turner Settlers of the first part
 Benjamin Cobb Jeremiah Cobb John & Peter Henry Melch
 and Thomas Fitzhugh Gent Trustees as herein after mentioned of the second
 part and Thomas Ridley of the County of Southampton of the third part
 Witnesseth that whereas by an act of the General Assembly of Virginia passed
 the 12th day of January 1820 Amendment of the act passed the 20th day of
 January 1819 concerning the Settlers of the Commonwealth of Indians the said
 Trustees or a Majority of them by and with the consent of the said Indians
 are authorized to lay off and make sale of Certain Certain and thereby
 four and eight Acres of land in the County of Southampton belong-
 ing to the Settlers of Indians first dividing the same into four
 equal tracts and the said Trustees or a Majority of them are by the first
 said recited act Authorized and empowering to join the said tribe of
 Indians in conveying the said land so sold to the purchaser or purcha-
 sers thereof in fee and whereas the said Trustees with the assistance
 of the County Surveyor have laid off by four equal tracts (and bounds)
 the aforesaid tract of land into four equal tracts as near as may
 practicable and having advertised the same according to the provision
 of the first recited act did on the 14th day of March 1820 propose
 to publish sale two hundred and eighty one acres of land being and
 fourth part of the said first mentioned tract described in the act
 of assembly at which sale the aforesaid Thomas Ridley being the
 highest bidder for the said land at the price of four dollars per acre
 became the purchaser thereof for this Indenture further Witnesseth
 that the said Indians and that the said Benjamin Cobb Jeremiah
 Cobb John & Peter Henry Melch and Thomas Fitzhugh Gent
 Trustees as aforesaid joining with the said Indians for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of Eleven hundred and twenty four dollars
 Money of Virginia he have paid to the said Trustees by the said
 Thomas Ridley or secured to be paid by the said Thomas Ridley to the
 said Trustees and their Successors have granted bargained and sold and by
 these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas
 Ridley his heirs and assigns the aforesaid tract of land containing
 two hundred and eighty one acres being a part of the said first
