This Indenture Inpartite made and executed the 1st day of March in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety

Joint Trustees as herein after mentioned of the Second Part and Thomas
Wiley of the County of Southampton of the Third Part Witnesseth
That Whereas by an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia passed
the 13th day of January 1820 to amend the Act passed the 30th day
of January 1819 Concerning the Mollonay tribe of Indians and
of Indians the said Trustees or a Majority of them by an act
with the consent of the said Indians are authorized to lay off and make
Sale of Eleven hundred and twenty four and five Eights acres of land
in the County of Southampton belonging to the Mollonay Tribe
of Indians first dividing the same into four equal parts and the
said Trustees or a majority of them are by the said first recited act
Authorized and empowered to give the said tribes of Indians in
conveying the said lands so sold to the purchaser or purchasers thereof
in fee and whereas the said trustees with the assistance of the County
Surveyor have laid off by proper miles and bounds the aforesaid tract of
Land into four tracts as nearly equal as it was practicable and
having advertised the same according to the provisions of the said first
recited act on the fourth day of March 1820 upon the said
Two hundred and eighty one acres of land being a part of the aforesaid
tract as expressed in the said Act of assembly at which sale
the aforesaid Thomas Wiley being the highest bidder for the said
Land at the price of Five dollars and ninety three cents for an acre
became the purchaser. Now this Indenture further witnesseth
that the said Indians and that the said Benjamin Cobb Enoch
Cobb John D. Hoot Henry Nelson and Thomas Fitzhugh of the
said tribes of Indians
