This Indenture made the second day of March
in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred and thirty between
Arthur Williamson of Southampton County of the one part
and Thomas Harrison of Solomons of the County aforesaid of the
other part witnesseth that the said Arthur Williamson in
consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and thirty dollars
at Law full money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by
the said Thomas Harrison at or before the delivery & delivering of
these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained
and sold and by these presents doth bargain and grant unto the said
Thomas Harrison his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of
Land situated lying and being in Southampton County on the South
Side of the three creeks containing by estimation one hundred and
forty one and 3/4 acres be the same more or less and bounded
as follows to wit on the South by the Land of William Allen Jones
and the West by the Land of Kinchen Williams which is a part of the
same tract cut by a line of new marked trees which was sold to
the said Williams by the North by the land of John Carhart and South
East by the Land of David Westbrook and Jesse Holt
To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land
together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in
any wise appertaining unto the said Thomas Harrison and his heirs and assigns
forever and behoof of the said Thomas Harrison and heirs and assigns
To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land
together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in
any wise appertaining unto the said Thomas Harrison and his heirs and assigns
from the claims or claims of him the said Arthur Williamson or his heirs
and of all and of every person or persons whatsoever that now and hereafter
and forever defend by these presents the witness whereof the said Arthur
Williamson have hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year before
