by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Mason
Simmons and his heirs all the tract or parcel of Land wherein
I now live in the County aforesd which I purchased of my Father Nicholas
Williams containing two hundred and one acres, being the same more or less
referred to the said deed the boundaries being fully appear
to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land together with
all appurtenances thereto the said Mason Simmons and
his heirs and the said John Williams and Rebecca his wife their and each
of their heirs exec and adm the said tract or parcel of Land with the
appurtenances to her the said Mason Simmons her heirs and assigns for
forever and the said John Williams and his wife Rebecca for them selves
their heirs of shall and will forever warrant and defend the title to
the aforesaid land against the claims or demands of all and every person
