

This Indenture

this 17th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and nineteen between Henry J. P. Westbrook of the
one part Spratly Williams of the second part and Thomas M
Pitts of the third part of the County of Southampton and State of
Virginia, Whereas the said Thomas M Pitts by this deed dated the
second day of March One thousand eight hundred and eighteen, and
admitted to record in the year 1818, in order to secure the payment
at the time therein specified of the sum of three hundred and forty
six dollars and thirty cents, as by his bond bearing date the 2^d
day of March 1815 - owing by him the said Thomas M Pitts
to the said Henry J. P. Westbrook conveyed in trust to the said
Spratly Williams a certain tract of land lying and being in
the County of Southampton and bounded by the lands of Benja
Lewis, Seth Nicholas, Benja Applewhite Francis Cotton and
Charlotte Westbrook (free Negro) and the said sum of three hund-
red and forty six dollars and thirty cents with the legal interest
thereon having been fully paid and satisfied by the said Thomas M Pitts
to the said Henry J. P. Westbrook in the said Westbrook hath requested
that the Estate conveyed by the said deed in trust for his benefit should
be now released to him the said Thomas M Pitts. This Indenture
therefore witnesseth That for and in consideration of the promises as also
for and in consideration of one dollar by the said Thomas M Pitts
to the said Spratly Williams in hand paid before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Spra-
tly Williams by and with the consent of the said Henry J. P. West-
brook signified by his being a party hereunto have granted released
and forever quit claimed and by these presents do fully and absolutely grant
convey and release and forever quit claim unto the said Thomas M Pitts
his heirs and assigns forever all the Estate right title interest possession
and claim and whatsoever in Law or equity of them and each of them
the said Spratly Williams or Henry J. P. Westbrook of in and to the
aforesaid tract of land with its appurtenances To have and to hold
the aforesaid tract of Land with its appurtenances to the said Thomas
M Pitts his heirs and assigns to the only use and behoof of the said
Thomas M Pitts his heirs and assigns forever so that the said Spratly
Williams and Henry J. P. Westbrook nor either of them nor either of
their heirs nor any other person whatsoever claiming under them
or either of them shall by any ways or means hereafter have
claim challenge or demand any estate right title or interest of
