with them and any of their increase if there should be any unto the said
Jesse Williams his heirs Executors administrators or assigns forever upon trust
nevertheless that the said Williams forever shall as soon as conveniently
after having ascertained the time and place of the sale of the property
before mentioned at last (but) days before the date thereof proceed
to sell the same to the highest bidder for the best price that can be
obtained and out of the money arising from the said sale in the
first place to pay and satisfy all reasonable charges attending
such sale and then the debt above mentioned and the residue of the
money arising from such sale as aforesaid to the use of the said Jesse
Williams his Executors administrators or assigns or to such person or
persons as the said Jesse Williams under his hand shall appoint and in
