 the sum of thirty dollars to him in hand paid the receipt of which he has
 hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
 doth grant bargain and sell unto Mesta Pope of the said County all
 my right title and interest claim or demands which I have of or
 unto a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in aforesaid
 County containing one hundred and four acres more or less and Eight
 parts of which I was entitled to by the death of my Father Elyah
 Morrell do have and to hold the said one eighth part of the said
 one hundred and four acres of Land which said Land is now in posses-
 sion of my mother Lydia Elyah Morrell unto him the said Mesta Pope
 as aforesaid and unto him his heirs and assigns forever against the
 claim of said Joseph Morrell his heirs and assigns and against
 the claim of all and every other person or persons whatsoever the whom
 whom I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
 day of October Eighteen hundred and Eighteen
